FIRST YEAR POST SECONDARY BURSARY APPLICATION**

Dalhousie Industrial Credit Union is pleased to offer its members and their children the opportunity of receiving its first year post secondary bursary. The bursary, in the amount of \$500.00, is awarded each year to two members in good standing to help defray the cost of their or their dependent children's first year of post secondary study. Two bursaries will be awarded annually, one to each applicant who has graduated, or whose graduation is pending, from A.Q.V. and Dalhousie High. The bursary will be made payable to the successful applicant and the institution being attended and will be forwarded directly to the institution for credit against the winner's tuition. Consideration of applications will be based primarily on financial need and secondly on academic achievement and extracurricular involvement.

In addition to the application, each applicant is required to provide the following supporting documentation.

1. Proof of acceptance from a university or community college in a program of at least one year in duration.
2. For pending graduates, the provision of their grade 11 transcript and grade 12 Christmas marks.

For applicants who have already graduated from high school, provision of both grade 11 and 12 transcripts.

All applications will be considered by the education committee but only the successful applicants will be notified of their decision. Deadline for applications is April 30 of each year. Each bursary will be awarded at the spring graduation where applicable.
